TIERED ENTITY ORGANIZATIONAL CHART INSTRUCTIONS

INSTRUCTIONS

This form is for use by a tiered-entity applicant to comply with A.R.S. § 32-1122(B)'s application disclosure requirements. A Tiered Entity is an entity that is owned or operated by another entity.

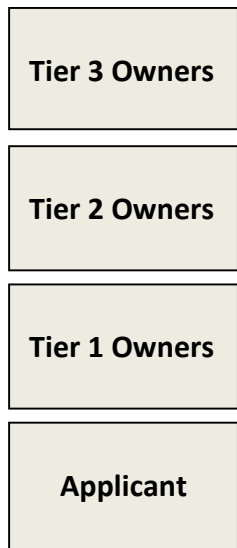
- For example, if applicant, "Red Corporation," is owned or operated by "Blue, LLC," "Red Corporation" would be considered a Tiered Entity for the purposes of obtaining a contractor's license (see chart below).

ORGANIZATIONAL CHART REQUIREMENTS

The chart must include the following information:

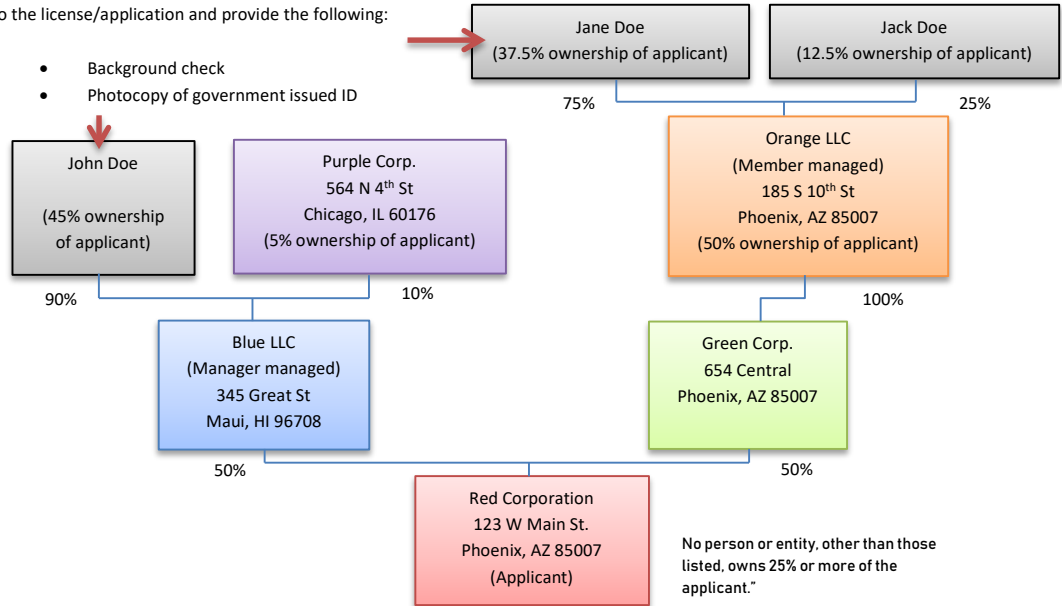
- 1. Under A.R.S. § 32-1122(B)(1)(d), if an applicant is a corporation, association, or other organization, the applicant must disclose the names and addresses of all owners of twenty-five percent (25%) or more of the stock or beneficial interest of the applicant.
2. For any individual that owns 25% or more of the stock or beneficial interest of the applicant, the applicant must identify those individual(s) by name and address on this form.
3. The Organizational Chart must be signed by an Authorized Representative with the following attestation, "No person or entity, other than those listed, owns 25% or more of the applicant."
4. Ownership percentages must be listed on the chart for each owning entity and individual.

EXAMPLE



Any person owning 25% or more beneficial interest in the applicant must include the appropriate form to be added to the license/application and provide the following:

- Background check
Photocopy of government issued ID



No person or entity, other than those listed, owns 25% or more of the applicant.
